A BILL

To amend title 44, United States Code, to require each agency to include a contact telephone number in its collection of information.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AGENCY CONTACT INFORMATION REQUIRE-**
4 **MENT.**

5 Section 3506(c)(1)(B)(iii) of title 44, United States
6 Code, is amended—

7 (1) in subclause (IV) by striking “and” at the
8 end; and

9 (2) by adding at the end the following:

1 “(VI) the agency’s contact tele-
2 phone number; and”.

3 **SEC. 2. STUDY AND REPORT.**

4 Not later than 2 years after the date of enactment
5 of this Act, the Comptroller General shall—

6 (1) conduct a study on—

7 (A) the number of complaints made to an
8 agency or other entity by a person receiving the
9 collection of information from an agency with
10 respect to such agency’s contact telephone num-
11 ber, or lack thereof; and

12 (B) the status of the resolution of such
13 complaints by such agency; and

14 (2) submit a report on the findings of such
15 study to each House of Congress.

16 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

17 The amendment made by section 1 shall take effect
18 1 year after the date of enactment of this Act.

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
