A BILL

To provide public safety officer disability benefits to officers disabled before the enactment of the Federal public safety officer disability benefits law.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Disabled Public Safety
5 Officers Fairness Act of 2008”.

6 **SEC. 2. DISABILITY BENEFITS FOR PUBLIC SAFETY OFFI-**
7 **CERS DISABLED BEFORE ENACTMENT OF**
8 **PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICER DISABILITY LAW.**

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1201(b) of the Omnibus
10 Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C.

1 3796(b)) is amended by inserting after “determines that
2 a public safety officer has” the following: “, whether be-
3 fore, on, or after the date of the enactment of this Act,”.

4 (b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendment made by sub-
5 section (a) applies to any public safety officer alive on or
6 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
