3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Mental Health for He-
5 roes’ Families Act of 2008”.

2 **ERANS AFFAIRS TO PROVIDE COUNSELING**
3 **FOR FAMILY MEMBERS OF VETERANS RE-**
4 **CEIVING NON-SERVICE-CONNECTED TREAT-**
