Mr. KAGEN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, and in addition to the Committee on Natural Resources, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned

A BILL

To ban the export of Alaskan oil.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Oil for Americans
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. BAN ON EXPORT OF ALASKAN OIL.**

7 (a) REPEAL OF PROVISION AUTHORIZING EX-
8 PORTS.—Section 28(s) of the Mineral Leasing Act (30
9 U.S.C. 185(s)) is repealed.

1 (b) REIMPOSITION OF PROHIBITION ON CRUDE OIL
2 EXPORTS.—Upon the effective date of this Act, subsection
3 (d) of section 7 of the Export Administration Act of 1979
4 (50 U.S.C. App. 2406(d)), shall be effective, and any other
5 provision of that Act (including sections 11 and 12) shall
6 be effective to the extent necessary to carry out such sec-
7 tion 7(d), notwithstanding section 20 of that Act or any
8 other provision of law that would otherwise allow exports
9 of oil to which such section 7(d) applies.
