3 **SECTION 1. FIRST LIEUTENANT NOAH HARRIS ELLIJAY**
4 **POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
6 Postal Service located at 801 Industrial Boulevard in

1 Ellijay, Georgia, shall be known and designated as the
2 “First Lieutenant Noah Harris Ellijay Post Office Build-
3 ing”.

4 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
5 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
6 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
7 be deemed to be a reference to the “First Lieutenant Noah
8 Harris Ellijay Post Office Building”.
