## A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to require that each member of the Armed Forces receive employment assistance, job training assistance, and other transitional services provided by the Secretary of Labor before that member separates from active duty service.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. REQUIREMENT THAT EACH MEMBER OF THE**  
2 **ARMED FORCES RECEIVE EMPLOYMENT AS-**  
3 **SISTANCE, JOB TRAINING ASSISTANCE, AND**  
4 **OTHER TRANSITIONAL SERVICES PROVIDED**  
5 **BY THE SECRETARY OF LABOR.**

6 (a) **REQUIREMENT.**—Subsection (a)(1) of section  
7 1144 of title 10, United States Code, is amended by strik-  
8 ing “Such services shall be provided to a member” and  
9 inserting “Where such services are available on a routine  
10 basis, the Secretary concerned shall require each member  
11 to receive such services”.

12 (b) **CONFORMING AMENDMENT.**—Such section is fur-  
13 ther amended by striking subsection (c).

14 (c) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendments made by  
15 subsections (a) and (b) shall apply with respect to a mem-  
16 ber of the Armed Forces whose discharge or release from  
17 active duty service is anticipated on or after the date of  
18 the enactment of this Act.
