A BILL

To amend title 23, United States Code, to authorize States to issue special permits to allow the operation of vehicles of not to exceed 95,000 pounds on Interstate System highways for the hauling of livestock.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. VEHICLE WEIGHT LIMITATIONS FOR INTER-**
4 **STATE SYSTEM HIGHWAYS.**

5 Section 127(a) of title 23, United States Code, is
6 amended by adding at the end the following:

7 “(13) HAULING OF LIVESTOCK.—A State may
8 allow, by special permit, the operation of vehicles

1 with a gross vehicle weight of not to exceed 95,000
2 pounds for the hauling of livestock. The cost of a
3 special permit issued under this paragraph may not
4 exceed \$200 per year for a livestock trailer.”.
