AN ACT

To provide for the release of certain land from the Sunrise Mountain Instant Study Area in the State of Nevada and to grant a right-of-way across the released land for the construction and maintenance of a flood control project.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Orchard Detention
3 Basin Flood Control Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. RELEASE OF CERTAIN LAND IN THE SUNRISE**
5 **MOUNTAIN INSTANT STUDY AREA.**

6 (a) FINDING.—Congress finds that the land de-
7 scribed in subsection (c) has been adequately studied for
8 wilderness designation under section 603 of the Federal
9 Land Policy and Management Act of 1976 (43 U.S.C.
10 1782).

11 (b) RELEASE.—The land described in subsection
12 (c)—

13 (1) is no longer subject to section 603(c) of the
14 Federal Land Policy and Management Act of 1976
15 (43 U.S.C. 1782(c)); and

16 (2) shall be managed in accordance with—

17 (A) land management plans adopted under
18 section 202 of that Act (43 U.S.C. 1712); and

19 (B) cooperative conservation agreements in
20 existence on the date of the enactment of this
21 Act.

22 (c) DESCRIPTION OF LAND.—The land referred to in
23 subsections (a) and (b) is the approximately 65 acres of
24 land in the Sunrise Mountain Instant Study Area of Clark
25 County, Nevada, that is—
