Ms. MATSUI, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

# RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2537) to amend the Federal Water Pollution Control Act relating to beach monitoring, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the State of the Union for consid-  
5 eration of the bill (H.R. 2537) to amend the Federal  
6 Water Pollution Control Act relating to beach monitoring,  
7 and for other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall

1 be dispensed with. All points of order against consider-  
2 ation of the bill are waived except those arising under  
3 clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. General debate shall be con-  
4 fined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally di-  
5 vided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minor-  
6 ity member of the Committee on Transportation and In-  
7 frastructure. After general debate the bill shall be consid-  
8 ered for amendment under the five-minute rule. It shall  
9 be in order to consider as an original bill for the purpose  
10 of amendment under the five-minute rule the amendment  
11 in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Com-  
12 mittee on Transportation and Infrastructure now printed  
13 in the bill. The committee amendment in the nature of  
14 a substitute shall be considered as read. All points of order  
15 against the committee amendment in the nature of a sub-  
16 stitute are waived except those arising under clause 10  
17 of rule XXI. Notwithstanding clause 11 of rule XVIII, no  
18 amendment to the committee amendment in the nature  
19 of a substitute shall be in order except those printed in  
20 the portion of the Congressional Record designated for  
21 that purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII before the begin-  
22 ning of consideration of the bill and except pro forma  
23 amendments for the purpose of debate. Each amendment  
24 so printed may be offered only by the Member who caused  
25 it to be printed or his designee and shall be considered

1 as read. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for  
2 amendment the Committee shall rise and report the bill  
3 to the House with such amendments as may have been  
4 adopted. Any Member may demand a separate vote in the  
5 House on any amendment adopted in the Committee of  
6 the Whole to the bill or to the committee amendment in  
7 the nature of a substitute. The previous question shall be  
8 considered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto  
9 to final passage without intervening motion except one  
10 motion to recommit with or without instructions.

11       SEC. 2. During consideration in the House of H.R.  
12 2537 pursuant to this resolution, notwithstanding the op-  
13 eration of the previous question, the Chair may postpone  
14 further consideration of the bill to such time as may be  
15 designated by the Speaker.
