Mr. ARCURI, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2830) to authorize appropriations for the Coast Guard for fiscal year 2008, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the State of the Union for consid-
5 eration of the bill (H.R. 2830) to authorize appropriations
6 for the Coast Guard for fiscal year 2008, and for other
7 purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed

1 with. All points of order against consideration of the bill
2 are waived except those arising under clause 9 or 10 of
3 rule XXI. General debate shall be confined to the bill and
4 shall not exceed one hour, with 40 minutes equally divided
5 and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority
6 member of the Committee on Transportation and Infra-
7 structure and 20 minutes equally divided and controlled
8 by the chairman and ranking minority member of the
9 Committee on Homeland Security. After general debate
10 the bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-
11 minute rule. In lieu of the amendments in the nature of
12 a substitute recommended by the Committees on Trans-
13 portation and Infrastructure, Homeland Security, and the
14 Judiciary now printed in the bill, it shall be in order to
15 consider as an original bill for the purpose of amendment
16 under the five-minute rule the amendment in the nature
17 of a substitute printed in part A of the report of the Com-
18 mittee on Rules accompanying this resolution. That
19 amendment in the nature of a substitute shall be consid-
20 ered as read. All points of order against that amendment
21 in the nature of a substitute are waived except those aris-
22 ing under clause 10 of rule XXI. Notwithstanding clause
23 11 of rule XVIII, no amendment to that amendment in
24 the nature of a substitute shall be in order except those
25 printed in part B of the report of the Committee on Rules.

1 Each amendment may be offered only in the order printed
2 in the report, may be offered only by a Member designated
3 in the report, shall be considered as read, shall be debat-
4 able for the time specified in the report equally divided
5 and controlled by the proponent and an opponent, shall
6 not be subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to
7 a demand for division of the question in the House or in
8 the Committee of the Whole. All points of order against
9 such amendments are waived except those arising under
10 clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. At the conclusion of consider-
11 ation of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise
12 and report the bill to the House with such amendments
13 as may have been adopted. Any Member may demand a
14 separate vote in the House on any amendment adopted
15 in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to the amend-
16 ment in the nature of a substitute made in order as origi-
17 nal text. The previous question shall be considered as or-
18 dered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage
19 without intervening motion except one motion to recommit
20 with or without instructions.

21 SEC. 2. In the engrossment of H.R. 2830, the Clerk
22 shall—

23 (a) add the text of H.R. 2399, as passed by the
24 House, as new matter at the end of H.R. 2830;

1 (b) conform the title of H.R. 2830 to reflect the addi-
2 tion to the engrossment of H.R. 2399;

3 (c) assign appropriate designations to provisions
4 within the engrossment; and

5 (d) conform provisions for short titles within the en-
6 grossment.

7 SEC. 3. During consideration in the House of H.R.
8 2830 pursuant to this resolution, notwithstanding the op-
9 eration of the previous question, the Chair may postpone
10 further consideration of the bill to such time as may be
11 designated by the Speaker.

12 SEC. 4. The chairman of the Committee on the Judi-
13 ciary is authorized, on behalf of the Committee, to file a
14 supplemental report to accompany H.R. 2830.
