RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the Senate amendment to the bill (H.R. 493) to prohibit discrimination on the basis of genetic information with respect to health insurance and employment.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to take from the Speaker's table the bill
3 (H.R. 493) to prohibit discrimination on the basis of ge-
4 netic information with respect to health insurance and em-
5 ployment, with the Senate amendment thereto, and to con-
6 sider in the House, without intervention of any point of

1 order except those arising under clause 10 of rule XXI,
2 a motion offered by the chairman of the Committee on
3 Education and Labor or his designee that the House con-
4 cur in the Senate amendment. The Senate amendment
5 and the motion shall be considered as read. The motion
6 shall be debatable for one hour, with 20 minutes equally
7 divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-
8 nority member of the Committee on Education and Labor,
9 20 minutes equally divided and controlled by the chairman
10 and ranking minority member of the Committee on En-
11 ergy and Commerce, and 20 minutes equally divided and
12 controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member
13 of the Committee on Ways and Means. The previous ques-
14 tion shall be considered as ordered on the motion to its
15 adoption without intervening motion.

16 SEC. 2. During consideration of the motion to concur
17 pursuant to this resolution, notwithstanding the operation
18 of the previous question, the Chair may postpone further
19 consideration of the motion to such time as may be des-
20 ignated by the Speaker.
