RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the Senate amendments to the House amendments to the Senate amendment to the bill (H.R. 2642) making appropriations for military construction, the Department of Veterans Affairs, and related agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2008, and for other purposes.

- 1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
- 2 shall be in order to take from the Speaker's table the bill
- 3 (H.R. 2642) making appropriations for military construc-

1 tion, the Department of Veterans Affairs, and related
2 agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2008,
3 and for other purposes, with the Senate amendments to
4 the House amendments to the Senate amendment thereto,
5 and to consider in the House, without intervention of any
6 point of order except those arising under clause 10 of rule
7 XXI, a single motion offered by the chairman of the Com-
8 mittee on Appropriations or his designee that the House
9 (1) concur in the Senate amendment to the House amend-
10 ment numbered 1 and (2) concur in the Senate amend-
11 ment to the House amendment numbered 2 with the
12 amendment printed in the report of the Committee on
13 Rules accompanying this resolution. The Senate amend-
14 ments and the motion shall be considered as read. The
15 motion shall be debatable for one hour equally divided and
16 controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member
17 of the Committee on Appropriations. The previous ques-
18 tion shall be considered as ordered on the motion to final
19 adoption without intervening motion or demand for divi-
20 sion of the question except that the Chair shall divide the
21 question between the dispositions of the two Senate
22 amendments.

23 SEC. 2. During consideration of the motion to concur
24 pursuant to this resolution, notwithstanding the operation
25 of the previous question, the Chair may postpone further

1 consideration of the motion to such time as may be des-
2 ignated by the Speaker.

3 SEC. 3. The chairman of the Committee on Appro-
4 priations may insert in the daily issue of the Congressional
5 Record dated June 19, 2008, such material as he may
6 deem explanatory of the motion.

7 SEC. 4. It shall be in order, any rule of the House
8 to the contrary notwithstanding, to consider concurrent
9 resolutions providing for the adjournment of the House
10 and Senate during the month of July.
