RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 6304) to amend the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act of 1978 to establish a procedure for authorizing certain acquisitions of foreign intelligence, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 6304) to amend the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act
4 of 1978 to establish a procedure for authorizing certain
5 acquisitions of foreign intelligence, and for other purposes.
6 All points of order against consideration of the bill are

1 waived except those arising under clause 9 or 10 of rule
2 XXI. The bill shall be considered as read. All points of
3 order against provisions of the bill are waived. The pre-
4 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the bill
5 to final passage without intervening motion except: (1) one
6 hour of debate equally divided among and controlled by
7 the chairman and ranking minority member of the Com-
8 mittee on the Judiciary and the chairman and ranking mi-
9 nority member of the Permanent Select Committee on In-
10 telligence; and (2) one motion to recommit.

11 SEC. 2. During consideration of H.R. 6304 pursuant
12 to this resolution, notwithstanding the operation of the
13 previous question, the Chair may postpone further consid-
14 eration of the bill to such time as may be designated by
15 the Speaker.
