Mr. WELCH, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

---

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 547) to facilitate the development of markets for alternative fuels and Ultra Low Sulfur Diesel fuel through research, development, and demonstration and data collection.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 547) to facilitate the development  
6 of markets for alternative fuels and Ultra Low Sulfur Die-

1 sel fuel through research, development, and demonstration  
2 and data collection. The first reading of the bill shall be  
3 dispensed with. All points of order against consideration  
4 of the bill are waived except those arising under clause  
5 9 or 10 of rule XXI. General debate shall be confined to  
6 the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and  
7 controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member  
8 of the Committee on Science and Technology. After gen-  
9 eral debate the bill shall be considered for amendment  
10 under the five-minute rule. It shall be in order to consider  
11 as an original bill for the purpose of amendment under  
12 the five-minute rule the amendment in the nature of a sub-  
13 stitute recommended by the Committee on Science and  
14 Technology now printed in the bill. Each section of the  
15 committee amendment in the nature of a substitute shall  
16 be considered as read. During consideration of the bill for  
17 amendment, the Chairman of the Committee of the Whole  
18 may accord priority in recognition on the basis of whether  
19 the Member offering an amendment has caused it to be  
20 printed in the portion of the Congressional Record des-  
21 ignated for that purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII. Amend-  
22 ments so printed shall be considered as read. At the con-  
23 clusion of consideration of the bill for amendment the  
24 Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House with  
25 such amendments as may have been adopted. Any Member

1 may demand a separate vote in the House on any amend-  
2 ment adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the bill  
3 or to the committee amendment in the nature of a sub-  
4 stitute. The previous question shall be considered as or-  
5 dered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage  
6 without intervening motion except one motion to recommit  
7 with or without instructions.
