RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 7201) to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to provide incentives for energy production and conservation, and for other purposes and providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 7202) to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to extend certain expiring provisions, to provide individual income tax relief, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.

1 7201) to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to
2 provide incentives for energy production and conservation,
3 and for other purposes. All points of order against consid-
4 eration of the bill are waived except those arising under
5 clause 10 of rule XXI. The bill shall be considered as read.
6 All points of order against the bill are waived. The pre-
7 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the bill
8 to final passage without intervening motion except: (1) one
9 hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the chair-
10 man and ranking minority member of the Committee on
11 Ways and Means; and (2) one motion to recommit.

12 SEC. 2. Upon adoption of this resolution it shall be
13 in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 7202)
14 to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to extend
15 certain expiring provisions, to provide individual income
16 tax relief, and for other purposes. All points of order
17 against consideration of the bill are waived except those
18 arising under clause 10 of rule XXI. The bill shall be con-
19 sidered as read. All points of order against the bill are
20 waived. The previous question shall be considered as or-
21 dered on the bill to final passage without intervening mo-
22 tion except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and
23 controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member
24 of the Committee on Ways and Means; and (2) one motion
25 to recommit.

1 SEC. 3. During consideration of H.R. 7201 or H.R.
2 7202 pursuant to this resolution, notwithstanding the op-
3 eration of the previous question, the Chair may postpone
4 further consideration of either bill to such time as may
5 be designated by the Speaker.
