Ms. SUTTON, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 800) to amend the National Labor Relations Act to establish an efficient system to enable employees to form, join, or assist labor organizations, to provide for mandatory injunctions for unfair labor practices during organizing efforts, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee

1 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
2 ation of the bill (H.R. 800) to amend the National Labor
3 Relations Act to establish an efficient system to enable
4 employees to form, join, or assist labor organizations, to
5 provide for mandatory injunctions for unfair labor prac-
6 tices during organizing efforts, and for other purposes.
7 The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All
8 points of order against consideration of the bill are waived
9 except those arising under clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI.
10 General debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not
11 exceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the
12 chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee
13 on Education and Labor. After general debate the bill
14 shall be considered for amendment under the five-minute
15 rule. It shall be in order to consider as an original bill
16 for the purpose of amendment under the five-minute rule
17 the amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended
18 by the Committee on Education and Labor now printed
19 in the bill. The committee amendment in the nature of
20 a substitute shall be considered as read. Notwithstanding
21 clause 11 of rule XVIII, no amendment to the committee
22 amendment in the nature of a substitute shall be in order
23 except those printed in the report of the Committee on
24 Rules accompanying this resolution. Each such amend-
25 ment may be offered only in the order printed in the re-

1 port, may be offered only by a Member designated in the
2 report, shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for
3 the time specified in the report equally divided and con-
4 trolled by the proponent and an opponent, shall not be
5 subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to a de-
6 mand for division of the question in the House or in the
7 Committee of the Whole. All points of order against such
8 amendments are waived except those arising under clause
9 10 of rule XXI. At the conclusion of consideration of the
10 bill for amendment the Committee shall rise and report
11 the bill to the House with such amendments as may have
12 been adopted. Any Member may demand a separate vote
13 in the House on any amendment adopted in the Com-
14 mittee of the Whole to the bill or to the committee amend-
15 ment in the nature of a substitute. The previous question
16 shall be considered as ordered on the bill and amendments
17 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except
18 one motion to recommit with or without instructions.
