Ms. CASTOR, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 720) to amend the Federal Water Pollution Control Act to authorize appropriations for State water pollution control revolving funds, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 720) to amend the Federal Water
6 Pollution Control Act to authorize appropriations for

1 State water pollution control revolving funds, and for
2 other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be dis-
3 pensed with. All points of order against consideration of
4 the bill are waived except those arising under clause 9 or
5 10 of rule XXI. General debate shall be confined to the
6 bill and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and con-
7 trolled by the chairman and ranking minority member of
8 the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.
9 After general debate the bill shall be considered for
10 amendment under the five-minute rule. The amendment
11 in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Com-
12 mittee on Transportation and Infrastructure now printed
13 in the bill, modified by the amendment printed in part A
14 of the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying
15 this resolution, shall be considered as adopted in the
16 House and in the Committee of the Whole. The bill, as
17 amended, shall be considered as the original bill for the
18 purpose of further amendment under the five-minute rule
19 and shall be considered as read. All points of order against
20 provisions in the bill, as amended, are waived. Notwith-
21 standing clause 11 of rule XVIII, no further amendment
22 to the bill, as amended, shall be in order except those
23 printed in part B of the report of the Committee on Rules.
24 Each further amendment may be offered only in the order
25 printed in the report, may be offered only by a Member

1 designated in the report, shall be considered as read, shall
2 be debatable for the time specified in the report equally
3 divided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent,
4 shall not be subject to amendment, and shall not be sub-
5 ject to a demand for division of the question in the House
6 or in the Committee of the Whole. All points of order
7 against such further amendments are waived except those
8 arising under clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. At the conclusion
9 of consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee
10 shall rise and report the bill, as amended, to the House
11 with such further amendments as may have been adopted.
12 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
13 the bill and amendments thereto to final passage without
14 intervening motion except one motion to recommit with
15 or without instructions.
