RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1433) to provide for the treatment of the District of Columbia as a Congressional district for purposes of representation in the House of Representatives, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 1433) to provide for the treatment of the District of Co-
4 lumbia as a Congressional district for purposes of rep-
5 resentation in the House of Representatives, and for other

1 purposes. All points of order against consideration of the
2 bill are waived except those arising under clause 9 or 10
3 of rule XXI. The amendment printed in the report of the
4 Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution shall be
5 considered as adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be con-
6 sidered as read. All points of order against the bill, as
7 amended, are waived. The previous question shall be con-
8 sidered as ordered on the bill, as amended, to final passage
9 without intervening motion except: (1) one hour and twen-
10 ty minutes of debate, with one hour equally divided and
11 controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member
12 of the Committee on the Judiciary and 20 minutes equally
13 divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-
14 nority member of the Committee on Oversight and Gov-
15 ernment Reform; and (2) one motion to recommit with
16 or without instructions.

17 SEC. 2. During consideration of H.R. 1433 pursuant
18 to this resolution, notwithstanding the operation of the
19 previous question, the Chair may postpone further consid-
20 eration of the bill to a time designated by the Speaker.
