Ms. SUTTON, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the concurrent resolution (H. Con. Res. 99) revising the congressional budget for the United States Government for fiscal year 2007, establishing the congressional budget for the United States Government for fiscal year 2008, and setting forth appropriate budgetary levels for fiscal years 2009 through 2012.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee

1 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
2 ation of the concurrent resolution (H. Con. Res. 99) revis-
3 ing the congressional budget for the United States Gov-
4 ernment for fiscal year 2007, establishing the congres-
5 sional budget for the United States Government for fiscal
6 year 2008, and setting forth appropriate budgetary levels
7 for fiscal years 2009 through 2012. The first reading of
8 the concurrent resolution shall be dispensed with. All
9 points of order against consideration of the concurrent
10 resolution shall be dispensed with. All points of order
11 against consideration of the concurrent resolution are
12 waived. General debate shall not exceed four hours, with
13 three hours confined to the congressional budget equally
14 divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-
15 nority member of the Committee on the Budget and one
16 hour on the subject of economic goals and policies equally
17 divided and controlled by Representative Maloney of New
18 York and Representative Saxton of New Jersey or their
19 designees. After general debate the concurrent resolution
20 shall be considered for amendment under the five-minute
21 rule. The concurrent resolution shall be considered as
22 read. No amendment shall be in order except those printed
23 in the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying
24 this resolution. Each amendment may be offered only in
25 the order printed in the report, may be offered only by

1 a Member designated in the report, shall be considered
2 as read, shall be debatable for the time specified in the
3 report, and shall not be subject to amendment. All points
4 of order against the amendments printed in the report are
5 waived except that the adoption of an amendment in the
6 nature of a substitute shall constitute the conclusion of
7 consideration of the concurrent resolution for amendment.
8 After the conclusion of consideration of the concurrent
9 resolution for amendment, the Committee shall rise and
10 report the concurrent resolution to the House with such
11 amendment as may have been adopted. The previous ques-
12 tion shall be considered as ordered on the concurrent reso-
13 lution and amendments thereto to final adoption without
14 intervening motion except amendments offered by the
15 chairman of the Committee on the Budget pursuant to
16 section 305(a)(5) of the Congressional Budget Act of
17 1974 to achieve mathematical consistency. The concurrent
18 resolution shall not be subject to a demand for division
19 of the question of its adoption.

20 SEC. 2. During consideration in the House of House
21 Concurrent Resolution 99 pursuant to this resolution, not-
22 withstanding the operation of the previous question, the
23 Chair may postpone further consideration of the concur-
24 rent resolution to such time as may be designated by the
25 Speaker.
