Mr. HASTINGS of Florida, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1361) to improve the disaster relief programs of the Small Business Administration, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 1361) to improve the disaster relief
6 programs of the Small Business Administration, and for
7 other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be dis-

1 pensed with. All points of order against consideration of
2 the bill are waived except those arising under clause 9 or
3 10 of rule XXI. General debate shall be confined to the
4 bill and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and con-
5 trolled by the chairman and ranking minority member of
6 the Committee on Small Business. After general debate
7 the bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-
8 minute rule. The amendment in the nature of a substitute
9 recommended by the Committee on Small Business now
10 printed in the bill, modified by the amendment printed in
11 part A of the report of the Committee on Rules accom-
12 panying this resolution, shall be considered as adopted in
13 the House and in the Committee of the Whole. The bill,
14 as amended, shall be considered as the original bill for
15 the purpose of further amendment under the five-minute
16 rule and shall be considered as read. All points of order
17 against provisions in the bill, as amended, are waived.
18 Notwithstanding clause 11 of rule XVIII, no further
19 amendment to the bill, as amended, shall be in order ex-
20 cept those printed in part B of the report of the Com-
21 mittee on Rules. Each such further amendment may be
22 offered only in the order printed in the report, may be
23 offered only by a Member designated in the report, shall
24 be considered as read, shall be debatable for the time spec-
25 ified in the report equally divided and controlled by the

1 proponent and an opponent, shall not be subject to amend-
2 ment, and shall not be subject to a demand for division
3 of the question in the House or in the Committee of the
4 Whole. All points of order against such further amend-
5 ments are waived except those arising under clause 9 or
6 10 of rule XXI. At the conclusion of consideration of the
7 bill for amendment the Committee shall rise and report
8 the bill, as amended, to the House with such further
9 amendments as may have been adopted. The previous
10 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
11 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
12 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-
13 structions.

14 SEC. 2. During consideration in the House of H.R.
15 1361 pursuant to this resolution, notwithstanding the op-
16 eration of the previous question, the Chair may postpone
17 further consideration of the bill to such time as may be
18 designated by the Speaker.
