Ms. MATSUI, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1495) to provide for the conservation and development of water and related resources, to authorize the Secretary of the Army to construct various projects for improvements to rivers and harbors of the United States, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-

1 ation of the bill (H.R. 1495) to provide for the conserva-
2 tion and development of water and related resources, to
3 authorize the Secretary of the Army to construct various
4 projects for improvements to rivers and harbors of the
5 United States, and for other purposes. The first reading
6 of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order
7 against consideration of the bill are waived except those
8 arising under clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. General debate
9 shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour
10 equally divided and controlled by the chairman and rank-
11 ing minority member of the Committee on Transportation
12 and Infrastructure. After general debate the bill shall be
13 considered for amendment under the five-minute rule. It
14 shall be in order to consider as an original bill for the
15 purpose of amendment under the five-minute rule the
16 amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended by
17 the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure now
18 printed in the bill. The committee amendment in the na-
19 ture of a substitute shall be considered as read. All points
20 of order against the committee amendment in the nature
21 of a substitute are waived except those arising under
22 clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. Notwithstanding clause 11
23 of rule XVIII, no amendment to the committee amend-
24 ment in the nature of a substitute shall be in order except
25 those printed in the report of the Committee on Rules ac-

1 accompanying this resolution. Each such amendment may
2 be offered only in the order printed in the report, may
3 be offered only by a Member designated in the report,
4 shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for the time
5 specified in the report equally divided and controlled by
6 the proponent and an opponent, shall not be subject to
7 amendment, and shall not be subject to a demand for divi-
8 sion of the question in the House or in the Committee
9 of the Whole. All points of order against such amendments
10 are waived except those arising under clause 9 or 10 of
11 rule XXI. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill
12 for amendment the Committee shall rise and report the
13 bill to the House with such amendments as may have been
14 adopted. Any Member may demand a separate vote in the
15 House on any amendment adopted in the Committee of
16 the Whole to the bill or to the committee amendment in
17 the nature of a substitute. The previous question shall be
18 considered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto
19 to final passage without intervening motion except one
20 motion to recommit with or without instructions.

21 SEC. 2. During consideration in the House of H.R.
22 1495 pursuant to this resolution, notwithstanding the op-
23 eration of the previous question, the Chair may postpone
24 further consideration of the bill to such time as may be
25 designated by the Speaker.
