Ms. SUTTON, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 249) to restore the prohibition on the commercial sale and slaughter of wild free-roaming horses and burros.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 249) to restore the prohibition on
6 the commercial sale and slaughter of wild free-roaming
7 horses and burros. The first reading of the bill shall be

1 dispensed with. All points of order against consideration
2 of the bill are waived except those arising under clause
3 9 or 10 of rule XXI. General debate shall be confined to
4 the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and
5 controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member
6 of the Committee on Natural Resources. After general de-
7 bate the bill shall be considered for amendment under the
8 five-minute rule. The bill shall be considered as read. Not-
9 withstanding clause 11 of rule XVIII, no amendment to
10 the bill shall be in order except those printed in the portion
11 of the Congressional Record designated for that purpose
12 in clause 8 of rule XVIII and except pro forma amend-
13 ments for the purpose of debate. Each amendment so
14 printed may be offered only by the Member who caused
15 it to be printed or his designee and shall be considered
16 as read. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for
17 amendment the Committee shall rise and report the bill
18 to the House with such amendments as may have been
19 adopted. The previous question shall be considered as or-
20 dered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage
21 without intervening motion except one motion to recommit
22 with or without instructions.

23 SEC. 2. During consideration in the House of H.R.
24 249 pursuant to this resolution, notwithstanding the oper-
25 ation of the previous question, the Chair may postpone

- 1 further consideration of the bill to such time as may be
- 2 designated by the Speaker.
