Ms. SLAUGHTER, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2237) to provide for the redeployment of United States Armed Forces and defense contractors from Iraq, providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2206) making emergency supplemental appropriations for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2007, and for other purposes, and providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2207) making supplemental appropriations for agricultural and other emer-

gency assistance for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2007, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 2237) to provide for the redeployment of United States
4 Armed Forces and defense contractors from Iraq. All
5 points of order against the bill and against its consider-
6 ation are waived. The bill shall be considered as read. The
7 previous question shall be considered as ordered on the
8 bill to final passage without intervening motion except: (1)
9 one hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the
10 chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee
11 on Appropriations; and (2) one motion to recommit.

12 SEC. 2. Upon the adoption of this resolution it shall
13 be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 2206)
14 making emergency supplemental appropriations for the
15 fiscal year ending September 30, 2007, and for other pur-
16 poses. All points of order against consideration of the bill
17 are waived except those arising under clause 9 or 10 of
18 rule XXI. The amendment printed in part A of the report
19 of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution
20 shall be considered as adopted. The bill, as amended, shall
21 be considered as read. All points of order against the bill,
22 as amended, are waived. The previous question shall be
23 considered as ordered on the bill, as amended, to final pas-
24 sage without intervening motion except: (1) one hour of

1 debate equally divided and controlled by the chairman and
2 ranking minority member of the Committee on Appropria-
3 tions; and (2) one motion to recommit with or without in-
4 structions.

5 SEC. 3. Upon the adoption of this resolution it shall
6 be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 2207)
7 making supplemental appropriations for agricultural and
8 other emergency assistance for the fiscal year ending Sep-
9 tember 30, 2007, and for other purposes. All points of
10 order against consideration of the bill are waived except
11 those arising under clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. The
12 amendment printed in part B of the report of the Com-
13 mittee on Rules accompanying this resolution shall be con-
14 sidered as adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be consid-
15 ered as read. All points of order against the bill, as amend-
16 ed, are waived. The previous question shall be considered
17 as ordered on the bill, as amended, to final passage with-
18 out intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate
19 equally divided and controlled by the chairman and rank-
20 ing minority member of the Committee on Appropriations;
21 and (2) one motion to recommit with or without instruc-
22 tions.

23 SEC. 4. (a) In the engrossment of H.R. 2206, the
24 Clerk shall—

1 (1) await the disposition of H.R. 2237 and
2 H.R. 2207;

3 (2) add the respective texts of H.R. 2237 and
4 H.R. 2207, as passed by the House, as new matter
5 at the end of H.R. 2206;

6 (3) conform the title of H.R. 2206 to reflect the
7 addition of H.R. 2237 and H.R. 2207, as passed by
8 the House, to the engrossment;

9 (4) assign appropriate designations to provi-
10 sions within the engrossment; and

11 (5) conform cross-references and provisions for
12 short titles within the engrossment.

13 (b) Upon the addition of H.R. 2237 and H.R. 2207,
14 as passed by the House, to the engrossment of H.R. 2206,
15 H.R. 2237 and H.R. 2207 shall be laid on the table.

16 SEC. 5. During consideration of H.R. 2237, H.R.
17 2206, or H.R. 2207 pursuant to this resolution, notwith-
18 standing the operation of the previous question, the Chair
19 may postpone further consideration of any such bill to
20 such time as may be designated by the Speaker.
