Ms. SLAUGHTER, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the Senate amendment to the bill (H.R. 2206) making emergency supplemental appropriations and additional supplemental appropriations for agricultural and other emergency assistance for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2007, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to take from the Speaker's table the bill
3 (H.R. 2206) making emergency supplemental appropria-
4 tions and additional supplemental appropriations for agri-
5 cultural and other emergency assistance for the fiscal year

1 ending September 30, 2007, and for other purposes, with
2 the Senate amendment thereto, and to consider in the
3 House, without intervention of any point of order, a mo-
4 tion offered by the chairman of the Committee on Appro-
5 priations or his designee that the House concur in the
6 Senate amendment with the House amendments printed
7 in the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying
8 this resolution. The Senate amendment and the motion
9 shall be considered as read. The motion shall be debatable
10 for one hour equally divided and controlled by the chair-
11 man and ranking minority member of the Committee on
12 Appropriations. The previous question shall be considered
13 as ordered on the motion to its adoption without inter-
14 vening motion or demand for division of the question ex-
15 cept that the Chair shall divide the question of adoption
16 of the motion between the two House amendments.

17 SEC. 2. If both portions of the divided question speci-
18 fied in the first section of this resolution are adopted, the
19 action of the House shall be engrossed as a single amend-
20 ment to the Senate amendment to H.R. 2206.

21 SEC. 3. During consideration of the motion to concur
22 pursuant to this resolution, notwithstanding the operation
23 of the previous question, the Chair may postpone further
24 consideration of such motion to such time as may be des-
25 ignated by the Speaker.

1 SEC. 4. (a) During consideration in the Committee
2 of the Whole of a bill making supplemental appropriations
3 for military operations in Iraq or Afghanistan for fiscal
4 year 2008, before consideration of any other amendment,
5 it shall be in order to consider an amendment only pro-
6 posing to add to the bill the text of H.R. 2451. Such
7 amendment shall be considered as read, shall not be sub-
8 ject to amendment, and shall not be subject to a demand
9 for division of the question in the House or the Committee
10 of the Whole. All points of order against such amendment
11 are waived except those arising under clause 9 of rule
12 XXI.

13 (b) Subsection (a) shall not apply to a bill making
14 regular appropriations for the Department of Defense for
15 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2008.
