## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2831) to amend title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Age Discrimination in Employment Act of 1967, the Americans With Disabilities Act of 1990, and the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 to clarify that a discriminatory compensation decision or other practice that is unlawful under such Acts occurs each time compensation is paid pursuant to the discriminatory compensation decision or other practice, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution  
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.  
3 2831) to amend title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964,  
4 the Age Discrimination in Employment Act of 1967, the  
5 Americans With Disabilities Act of 1990, and the Reha-  
6 bilitation Act of 1973 to clarify that a discriminatory com-  
7 pensation decision or other practice that is unlawful under  
8 such Acts occurs each time compensation is paid pursuant  
9 to the discriminatory compensation decision or other prac-  
10 tice, and for other purposes. All points of order against  
11 consideration of the bill are waived except those arising  
12 under clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. The amendment in the  
13 nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee on  
14 Education and Labor now printed in the bill shall be con-  
15 sidered as adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be consid-  
16 ered as read. All points of order against provisions of the  
17 bill, as amended, are waived. The previous question shall  
18 be considered as ordered on the bill, as amended, to final  
19 passage without intervening motion except: (1) one hour  
20 of debate equally divided and controlled by the chairman  
21 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Edu-  
22 cation and Labor; and (2) one motion to recommit with  
23 or without instructions.

24       SEC. 2. During consideration of H.R. 2831 pursuant  
25 to this resolution, notwithstanding the operation of the

- 1 previous question, the Chair may postpone further consid-
- 2 eration of the bill to such time as may be designated by
- 3 the Speaker.
