RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of motions to suspend the rules.

1 *Resolved*, That it shall be in order at any time
2 through the legislative day of Friday, August 3, 2007, for
3 the Speaker to entertain motions that the House suspend
4 the rules relating to the following measures:

5 (1) The bill (H.R. 3087) to require the Presi-
6 dent, in coordination with the Secretary of State, the
7 Secretary of Defense, the Joint Chiefs of Staff, and
8 other senior military leaders, to develop and trans-

1 mit to Congress a comprehensive strategy for the re-
2 deployment of United States Armed Forces in Iraq.

3 (2) A bill to amend the Foreign Intelligence
4 Surveillance Act of 1978 to establish a procedure for
5 authorizing certain electronic surveillance.
