Mr. CARDOZA, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3567) to amend the Small Business Investment Act of 1958 to expand opportunities for investments in small businesses, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 3567) to amend the Small Business
6 Investment Act of 1958 to expand opportunities for invest-

1 ments in small businesses, and for other purposes. The
2 first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points
3 of order against consideration of the bill are waived except
4 those arising under clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. General
5 debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed
6 one hour equally divided and controlled by the chairman
7 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Small
8 Business. After general debate the bill shall be considered
9 for amendment under the five-minute rule. The bill shall
10 be considered as read. All points of order against provi-
11 sions of the bill are waived. Notwithstanding clause 11 of
12 rule XVIII, no amendment to the bill shall be in order
13 except those printed in the report of the Committee on
14 Rules accompanying this resolution. Each such amend-
15 ment may be offered only in the order printed in the re-
16 port, may be offered only by a Member designated in the
17 report, shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for
18 the time specified in the report equally divided and con-
19 trolled by the proponent and an opponent, shall not be
20 subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to a de-
21 mand for division of the question in the House or in the
22 Committee of the Whole. All points of order against such
23 amendments are waived except those arising under clause
24 9 or 10 of rule XXI. At the conclusion of consideration
25 of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise and

1 report the bill to the House with such amendments as may
2 have been adopted. The previous question shall be consid-
3 ered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to
4 final passage without intervening motion except one mo-
5 tion to recommit with or without instructions.

6 SEC. 2. During consideration in the House of H.R.
7 3567 pursuant to this resolution, notwithstanding the op-
8 eration of the previous question, the Chair may postpone
9 further consideration of the bill to such time as may be
10 designated by the Speaker.
