4 734) expressing the sense of the House of Representatives
5 regarding the withholding of information relating to cor-

1 ruption in Iraq. The resolution shall be considered as read.
2 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
3 the resolution to final adoption without intervening motion
4 or demand for division of the question except: (1) one hour
5 of debate equally divided and controlled by the chairman
6 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Over-
7 sight and Government Reform; and (2) one motion to re-
8 commit which may not contain instructions.
