RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3773) to amend the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act of 1978 to establish a procedure for authorizing certain acquisitions of foreign intelligence, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 3773) to amend the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act
4 of 1978 to establish a procedure for authorizing certain
5 acquisitions of foreign intelligence, and for other purposes.

1 All points of order against consideration of the bill are
2 waived except those arising under clause 9 or 10 of rule
3 XXI. In lieu of the amendments recommended by the
4 Committee on the Judiciary and the Permanent Select
5 Committee on Intelligence now printed in the bill, the
6 amendment in the nature of a substitute printed in part
7 A of the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying
8 this resolution, modified by the amendment printed in part
9 B of such report, shall be considered as adopted. The bill,
10 as amended, shall be considered as read. All points of
11 order against provisions of the bill, as amended, are
12 waived. The previous question shall be considered as or-
13 dered on the bill, as amended, to final passage without
14 intervening motion except: (1) one hour and 30 minutes
15 of debate, with one hour equally divided and controlled by
16 the chairman and ranking minority member of the Com-
17 mittee on the Judiciary and 30 minutes equally divided
18 and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority
19 member of the Permanent Select Committee on Intel-
20 ligence; and (2) one motion to recommit with or without
21 instructions.

22 SEC. 2. During consideration of H.R. 3773 pursuant
23 to this resolution, notwithstanding the operation of the
24 previous question, the Chair may postpone further consid-

- 1 eration of the bill to such time as may be designated by
- 2 the Speaker.
