# RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the Senate amendments to the bill (H.R. 6) to reduce our Nation's dependency on foreign oil by investing in clean, renewable, and alternative energy resources, promoting new emerging energy technologies, developing greater efficiency, and creating a Strategic Energy Efficiency and Renewables Reserve to invest in alternative energy, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it  
2 shall be in order to take from the Speaker's table the bill

1 (H.R. 6) to reduce our Nation's dependency on foreign  
2 oil by investing in clean, renewable, and alternative energy  
3 resources, promoting new emerging energy technologies,  
4 developing greater efficiency, and creating a Strategic En-  
5 ergy Efficiency and Renewables Reserve to invest in alter-  
6 native energy, and for other purposes, with Senate amend-  
7 ments thereto, and to consider in the House, without  
8 intervention of any point of order except those arising  
9 under clause 10 of rule XXI, a single motion offered by  
10 the Majority Leader or his designee that the House concur  
11 in each of the Senate amendments with the respective  
12 amendment printed in the report of the Committee on  
13 Rules accompanying this resolution. The Senate amend-  
14 ments and the motion shall be considered as read. The  
15 motion shall be debatable for one hour equally divided and  
16 controlled by the Majority Leader and the Minority Lead-  
17 er or their designees. The previous question shall be con-  
18 sidered as ordered on the motion to final adoption without  
19 intervening motion or demand for division of the question.

20       SEC. 2. During consideration in the House of the mo-  
21 tion to concur pursuant to this resolution, notwithstanding  
22 the operation of the previous question, the Chair may  
23 postpone further consideration of the bill to such time as  
24 may be designated by the Speaker.
