Mr. LEAHY (for himself, Mr. BROWNBACK, Mrs. FEINSTEIN, Mr. HAGEL, Mr. INOUE, Mr. ROBERTS, Mr. BROWN, Mr. VOINOVICH, Mr. NELSON of Nebraska, Mrs. BOXER, and Mr. AKAKA) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To create and extend certain temporary district court judgeships.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TEMPORARY JUDGESHIPS FOR DISTRICT**
4 **COURTS.**

5 (a) ADDITIONAL TEMPORARY JUDGESHIPS.—

6 (1) IN GENERAL.—The President shall appoint,
7 by and with the advice and consent of the Senate—

1 (A) 1 additional district judge for the east-
2 ern district of California; and

3 (B) 1 additional district judge for the dis-
4 trict of Nebraska.

5 (2) VACANCIES NOT FILLED.—The first va-
6 cancy in the office of district judge in each of the
7 offices of district judge authorized by this sub-
8 section, occurring 10 years or more after the con-
9 firmation date of the judge named to fill the tem-
10 porary district judgeship created in the applicable
11 district by this subsection, shall not be filled.

12 (b) EXTENSION OF CERTAIN TEMPORARY JUDGE-
13 SHIPS.—Section 203(c) of the Judicial Improvements Act
14 of 1990 (Public Law 101–650; 28 U.S.C. 133 note) is
15 amended—

16 (1) in the second sentence, by inserting “the
17 district of Hawaii,” after “Pennsylvania,”;

18 (2) in the third sentence (relating to the district
19 of Kansas), by striking “16 years” and inserting
20 “26 years”;

21 (3) in the fifth sentence (relating to the north-
22 ern district of Ohio), by striking “15 years” and in-
23 serting “25 years”; and

24 (4) by inserting “The first vacancy in the office
25 of district judge in the district of Hawaii occurring

1 20 years or more after the confirmation date of the
2 judge named to fill the temporary judgeship created
3 under this subsection shall not be filled.” after the
4 sixth sentence.
