To limit the simultaneous deployment to combat zones of dual-military couples who have minor dependents.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON SIMULTANEOUS DEPLOYMENT**

4 **TO COMBAT ZONES OF DUAL-MILITARY COU-**

5 **PLES WHO HAVE MINOR DEPENDENTS.**

6 In the case of a member of the Armed Forces with
7 minor dependents who has a spouse who is also a member
8 of the Armed Forces, and the spouse is deployed in an
9 area for which imminent danger pay is authorized under
10 section 310 of title 37, United States Code, the member

- 1 may request a deferment of a deployment to such an area
- 2 until the spouse returns from such deployment.
