2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MANDATORY REVOCATION OF PASSPORTS OF**
4 **INDIVIDUALS WHOSE CHILD SUPPORT PAY-**
5 **MENTS ARE MORE THAN \$2,500 IN ARREARS.**

6 Section 452(k) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
7 652(k)) is amended—

8 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “, revocation,
9 or limitation” and inserting “or revocation”; and

- 1 (2) in paragraph (2), by striking “may revoke,
- 2 restrict, or limit” and inserting “shall revoke”.
