**A BILL**

To make the moratorium on Internet access taxes and multiple and discriminatory taxes on electronic commerce permanent.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Permanent Internet  
5 Tax Freedom Act of 2007”.

1 **SEC. 2. PERMANENT MORATORIUM ON INTERNET ACCESS**  
2 **TAXES AND MULTIPLE AND DISCRIMINATORY**  
3 **TAXES ON ELECTRONIC COMMERCE.**

4 Section 1101(a) of the Internet Tax Freedom Act (47  
5 U.S.C. 151 note) is amended by striking “taxes during  
6 the period beginning November 1, 2003, and ending No-  
7 vember 1, 2007:” and inserting “taxes:”.
