Mr. ENSIGN (for himself and Mr. REID) introduced the following bill; which
was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural
Resources

A BILL

To provide for the release of any reversionary interest of
the United States in and to certain lands in Reno, Nevada.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RAILROAD LANDS DEFINED.**

4 For the purposes of this Act, the term “railroad
5 lands” means those lands within the City of Reno, Ne-
6 vada, located within portions of sections 10, 11, and 12
7 of T.19 N., R. 19 E., and portions of section 7 of T.19
8 N., R. 20 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada, that were
9 originally granted to the Union Pacific Railroad under the

1 provisions of the Act of July 1, 1862, commonly known
2 as the Union Pacific Railroad Act.

3 **SEC. 2. RELEASE OF REVERSIONARY INTEREST.**

4 Any reversionary interests of the United States (in-
5 cluding interests under the Act of July 1, 1862, commonly
6 known as the Union Pacific Railroad Act) in and to the
7 railroad lands as defined in section one of this Act are
8 hereby released.
