## A BILL

To make technical corrections to the Federal Insecticide,  
Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS TO THE FEDERAL**  
4                       **INSECTICIDE, FUNGICIDE, AND RODENTICIDE**  
5                       **ACT.**

6       (a) PESTICIDE REGISTRATION SERVICE FEES.—Sec-  
7       tion 33 of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and  
8       Rodenticide Act (7 U.S.C. 136w–8) is amended—

9               (1) in subsection (b)(7)—

10               (A) in subparagraph (D)—

1 (i) by striking clause (i) and inserting  
 2 the following:

3 “(i) IN GENERAL.—The Administrator  
 4 may exempt from, or waive a portion of,  
 5 the registration service fee for an applica-  
 6 tion for minor uses for a pesticide.”; and

7 (ii) in clause (ii), by inserting “or ex-  
 8 emption” after “waiver”; and

9 (B) in subparagraph (E)—

10 (i) in the paragraph heading, by strik-  
 11 ing “WAIVER” and inserting “EXEMP-  
 12 TION”;

13 (ii) by striking “waive the registration  
 14 service fee for an application” and insert-  
 15 ing “exempt an application from the reg-  
 16 istration service fee”; and

17 (iii) in clause (ii), by striking “waiv-  
 18 er” and inserting “exemption”; and

19 (2) in subsection (m)(2), by striking “2008”  
 20 each place it appears and inserting “2012”.

21 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
 22 subsection (a) take effect on October 1, 2007.
