A BILL

To prohibit the transport of hydrolysate from the Pueblo Chemical Depot, Colorado, to an off-site location.

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON TRANSPORT OF HYDROLY-**
4 **SATE FROM THE PUEBLO CHEMICAL DEPOT,**
5 **COLORADO.**

6 The Secretary of Defense may not transport hydroly-
7 sate from the Pueblo Chemical Depot, Colorado, to an off-
8 site location for treatment, storage, or disposal. Nothing
9 in this Act limits or otherwise affects the obligation of the
10 Secretary of Defense to complete work on the destruction

1 of the United States stockpile of lethal chemical weapons
2 and munitions under section 8119 of the Department of
3 Defense Appropriations Act, 2008 (Public Law 110–116;
4 50 U.S.C. 1521 note).
