2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF HIGHER EDUCATION PRO-**
4 **GRAMS.**

5 (a) EXTENSION OF PROGRAMS.—Section 2(a) of the
6 Higher Education Extension Act of 2005 (Public Law
7 109–81; 20 U.S.C. 1001 note) is amended by striking
8 “May 31, 2008” and inserting “June 30, 2008”.

9 (b) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in this sec-
10 tion, or in the Higher Education Extension Act of 2005

1 as amended by this Act, shall be construed to limit or oth-
2 erwise alter the authorizations of appropriations for, or
3 the durations of, programs contained in the amendments
4 made by the Higher Education Reconciliation Act of 2005
5 (Public Law 109–171), by the College Cost Reduction and
6 Access Act (Public Law 110–84), or by the Ensuring Con-
7 tinued Access to Student Loans Act of 2008 (Public Law
8 110–227) to the provisions of the Higher Education Act
9 of 1965 and the Taxpayer-Teacher Protection Act of
10 2004.

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
