## A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Army to establish, modify, charge, and collect recreation fees with respect to land and water administered by the Corps of Engineers.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Conserving Our Recre-  
5 ation and Park Services Act of 2008” or the “CORPS  
6 Act of 2008”.

7 **SEC. 2. AUTHORITY OF SECRETARY OF THE ARMY.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Beginning on October 1, 2008,  
9 the Secretary of the Army may establish, modify, charge,

1 and collect recreation fees with respect to any land or  
2 water administered by the Corps of Engineers in the same  
3 manner, and subject to the same terms and conditions,  
4 as the Secretary of the Interior may establish, modify,  
5 charge, and collect recreation fees with respect to Federal  
6 recreation land and water managed by the Bureau of Rec-  
7 lamation pursuant to the Federal Lands Recreation En-  
8 hancement Act (16 U.S.C. 6801 et seq.).

9 (b) USE OF SPECIAL ACCOUNT FOR DEPOSIT AND  
10 EXPENDITURE OF FEES.—The Secretary of the Treasury  
11 shall establish a special account in the Treasury of the  
12 United States for the Corps of Engineers, which shall be  
13 used for the same purpose, and subject to the same terms  
14 and conditions, as each special account established in the  
15 Treasury of the United States for each Federal land man-  
16 agement agency under section 807(a) of the Federal  
17 Lands Recreation Enhancement Act (16 U.S.C. 6806(a)).
