A BILL

For the relief of Ilko Vasilev Ivanov, Anelia Marinova Peneva, Marina Ilkova Ivanova, and Julia Ilkova Ivanova.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.**

4 In the administration of the Immigration and Nation-
5 ality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101 et seq.), Ilko Vasilev Ivanov,
6 Anelia Marinova Peneva, Marina Ilkova Ivanova, and
7 Julia Ilkova Ivanova shall be considered to have been law-
8 fully admitted to the United States for permanent resi-
9 dence as of the date of the enactment of this Act upon
10 payment of the required visa fees.

1 **SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.**

2 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Ilko
3 Vasilev Ivanov, Anelia Marinova Peneva, Marina Ilkova
4 Ivanova, and Julia Ilkova Ivanova as provided in this Act,
5 the Secretary of State shall instruct the proper officer to
6 reduce by 4 during the current or next following fiscal year
7 the total number of immigrant visas available to natives
8 of the country of the aliens' birth under section 202(a)(2)
9 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
10 1152(a)(2)).
