3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The Federal building located at 210 Walnut Street
5 in Des Moines, Iowa, shall be known and designated as
6 the “Neal Smith Federal Building”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal
4 building referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be
5 a reference to the “Neal Smith Federal Building”.
