A BILL

To modify the boundary of the Hopewell Culture National
Historical Park in the State of Ohio, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Hopewell Culture Na-
5 tional Historical Park Boundary Adjustment Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. BOUNDARY EXPANSION.**

7 Section 2 of the Act entitled “An Act to rename and
8 expand the boundaries of the Mound City Group National
9 Monument in Ohio”, approved May 27, 1992 (106 Stat.
10 185), is amended—

1 (1) by striking “and” at the end of subsection
2 (a)(3);

3 (2) by striking the period at the end of sub-
4 section (a)(4) and inserting “; and”;

5 (3) by adding after subsection (a)(4) the fol-
6 lowing new paragraph:

7 “(5) the map entitled ‘Hopewell Culture Na-
8 tional Historical Park, Ohio Proposed Boundary Ad-
9 justment’ numbered 353/80,049 and dated June,
10 2006.”; and

11 (4) by adding after subsection (d)(2) the fol-
12 lowing new paragraph:

13 “(3) The Secretary may acquire lands added by
14 subsection (a)(5) only from willing sellers.”.

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
