Ms. PRYCE, from the Committee on Rules, submitted the following

REPORT

[To accompany H. Res. 130]

The Committee on Rules, having had under consideration House Resolution 130, by a record vote of 7 to 4, report the same to the House with the recommendation that the resolution be adopted.

BRIEF SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS OF RESOLUTION

The resolution provides for the consideration of H.R. 483, the Medicare Select Expansion bill under a modified closed rule. The rule waives clause 2(l)(6) of rule XI, the three-day report availability requirement, against the consideration of the bill. The rule provides for one-hour of general debate divided equally between the chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee on Commerce. It is then in order to consider an amendment in the nature of a substitute consisting of the text of H.R. 1391 as the base bill for purposes of amendment. No further amendment is in order except an amendment in the nature of a substitute to be offered by Representative Dingell of Michigan or a designee. The substitute is not subject to amendment but is debatable for one-hour divided equally between the chairman and ranking minority member. The rule provides for one motion to recommit, with or without instructions. Finally the rule permits the filing of the Commerce Committee's report on H.R. 483 at any time. This latter provision is taken as a precautionary measure, though it is expected that the report of the Committee on Commerce will be filed with the House the day before the bill is considered.
