REPORT

[To accompany H. Res. 167]

The Committee on Rules, having had under consideration House Resolution 167, by a nonrecord vote, report the same to the House with the recommendation that the resolution be adopted.

BRIEF SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS OF RESOLUTION

The resolution provides for the consideration of H.R. 1817, the Military Construction Appropriations Act for fiscal year 1996 under an open rule. The rule provides one hour of general debate divided equally between the chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee on Appropriations.

The rule waives clause 2 (prohibiting unauthorized and legislative provisions) and clause 6 (prohibiting reappropriations) of rule XXI against provisions of the bill. The rule authorizes the Chair to accord priority in recognition to Members who have pre-printed their amendments in the Congressional Record. The rule provides one motion to recommit.

Section 2 of the rule provides that the spending and credit allocations to the Committee on Appropriations contained in the House passed budget resolution shall apply for Budget Act enforcement purposes until final adoption of a budget resolution. It is expected that the Committee on Appropriations will file its section 602(b) subcommittee allocations pursuant to this provision immediately following the adoption of the rule and prior to the consideration of the bill.
