

WAIVING THE PROVISIONS OF CLAUSE 4(B) OF HOUSE
RULE XI AGAINST THE CONSIDERATION OF CERTAIN
RESOLUTIONS REPORTED FROM THE RULES COMMITTEE

REPORT

The Committee on Rules, having had under consideration House Resolution 260, by a nonrecord vote, report the same to the House with the recommendation that the resolution be adopted.

BRIEF SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS OF RESOLUTION

The resolution waives clause 4(b) of rule XI, requiring a two-thirds vote to consider a rule on the same day it is reported from the Committee on Rules, against the same-day consideration of resolutions reported from the Rules Committee on or before the legislative day of November 13, 1995. The resolution covers special rules that provide for the consideration or disposition of any measure making further continuing appropriations; any measure including provisions increasing or waiving the public debt limit; and any amendment, conference report, or amendment reported in disagreement from a conference on such measures.

Finally, the rule clarifies that the provisions of the rule do not apply to any special rule for the consideration or disposition of reconciliation measures as defined by section 310 of the Budget Act.
