

PROVIDING FOR THE CONSIDERATION OF A MOTION TO DISPOSE OF THE REMAINING SENATE AMENDMENT TO THE BILL (H.R. 1868) MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR FOREIGN OPERATIONS, EXPORT FINANCING, AND RELATED PROGRAMS FOR FISCAL YEAR 1996

## REPORT

[To accompany H. Res. 296]

The Committee on Rules, having had under consideration House Resolution 296, by a nonrecord vote, report the same to the House with the recommendation that the resolution be adopted.

### BRIEF SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS OF RESOLUTION

The rule makes in order the motion printed in section 2 of the resolution, which disposes of the remaining Senate amendment to H.R. 1868, the foreign operations appropriations bill for fiscal year 1996. The motion is to be offered by Mr. Callahan or his designee. The Senate amendment and the motion shall be considered as read.

The rule waives all points of order against the motion and provides for one hour of debate equally divided between the proponent and an opponent. Finally, the rule provides that the previous question shall be considered as ordered on that motion to final adoption without intervening motion or demand for division of the question.

Sec. 2. The motion to dispose of the amendment of the Senate numbered 115 is as follows:

Mr. Callahan (or his designee) moves that the House recede from its amendment to the amendment of the Senate numbered 115, and concur therein with an amendment, as follows:

In lieu of the matter proposed by said amendment, insert:

#### “AUTHORIZATION OF POPULATION PLANNING

“SEC. 518A. Section 526 of this Act shall not apply to funds made available in this Act for population planning activities or other population assistance pursuant to section 104(b) of the Foreign Assist-

ance Act or any other provision of law, or to funds made available in title IV of this Act as a contribution to the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA).”
