REPORT

The Committee on Rules, having had under consideration House Resolution 317, by a record vote of 11 to 0, report the same to the House with the recommendation that the resolution be adopted.

BRIEF SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS OF RESOLUTION

The resolution provides for consideration in the House of H. J. Res. 134, "Making Continuing Appropriations to Ensure Payment of Veterans Benefits" under a closed rule. The rule provides one hour of general debate divided equally between the chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee on Appropriations.

Finally, the rule provides one motion to recommit which may only include instructions if offered by the Minority Leader or his designee.
