REPORT

[To accompany H. Res. 405]

The Committee on Rules, having had under consideration House Resolution 405, by a nonrecord vote, report the same to the House with the recommendation that the resolution be adopted.

BRIEF SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS OF RESOLUTION

The resolution waives all points of order against the conference report to accompany S. 735, the Terrorism Prevention Act, and against its consideration.

The blanket waiver includes a waiver of clause 3 of rule XXVIII, prohibiting inclusion of matters in conference reports not committed to conference by either House.
