The Committee on Rules, having had under consideration House Resolution 604, by a nonrecord vote, report the same to the House with the recommendation that the resolution be adopted.

BRIEF SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS OF RESOLUTION

The resolution provides for consideration in the House, without intervention of any point of order, of S. 1132 under a closed rule with one hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee on Resources. The rule provides one motion to recommit.

Furthermore, the rule provides for consideration in the House, without intervention of any point of order, of S. 2133 under a closed rule with one hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee on Resources. Finally the rule provides one motion to recommit.
