

WAIVING POINTS OF ORDER AGAINST THE CONFERENCE
REPORT TO ACCOMPANY H.R. 2465, THE MILITARY CON-
STRUCTION APPROPRIATIONS ACT, 2000

REPORT

[To accompany H. Res. 262]

The Committee on Rules, having had under consideration House Resolution 262, by a nonrecord vote, report the same to the House with the recommendation that the resolution be adopted.

SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS OF RESOLUTION

The resolution waives points of order against the conference report to accompany H.R. 2465, the “Military Construction Appropriations Act, 2000” and against its consideration. The rule further provides that the conference report shall be considered as read.

The waiver of all points of order against consideration of the conference report is necessary because the report is in violation of clause 8 of rule XXI (requiring a three day layover of any conference report). The waiver of points of order against the conference report is necessary because certain provisions in the report are in violation of clause 9 of rule XXII (violating the scope of the conference), and section 131 of the report is in violation of clause 5 of rule XXI (prohibiting tax or tariff provisions in a bill not reported by a committee with jurisdiction over revenue measures).
